## Milestone classes:

K-1 Sacraments classes in the fall, familiarize children with baptism and communion.

3rd grade Bible Classes in the winter give children a foundation of the Books of the Bible and each child receives a Bible.

## Camps

**Presbycamp** June and July week-long sessions of full day summer camp with 6 counselors and 32 campers. Registration for Presbycamp opens in February (this camp is for children who have completed K-5th grade - entering 1-6th in the fall)

**Music Camp** A week of summer camp led by our Minister of Music. Registration begins in February (this camp is for children in 1-7th grade - entering 2-8th in the fall)

**Sherwood Forest** This is a week long camp in the beautiful Calvin Crest camp SW of Yosemite. We travel to and home from camp together. Next summer's dates TBA. Registration begins in December.

**Kids In Mission** is a one day camp for those in 4-8th grade. It takes place on the Veteran's Day November holiday. We will plug into local missions. Registration begins in September.
