Wine Policy

- 1. The only alcoholic beverage to be served on the property of First Presbyterian Church of Santa Barbara located at 21 E. Constance Ave. shall be wine (hereafter including sparkling wine/Champagne). Hard liquor, beer and punch spiked with hard liquor **shall not be served** at any time.
- 2. Wine will be permitted at:
 - a. Wedding receptions
 - b. Wedding anniversary celebrations
 - c. Meals/receptions served for outside groups
 - d. Meals/receptions served for Church groups
- 3. A request to serve wine must be included with the Facilities Request Form and must have the approval of appropriate church officials. No alcoholic beverages shall be brought onto church property or served without prior approval.
- 4. Wine shall not be brought onto any area other than the Christian Fellowship Center or the Upper Patio (located between the parking lot and the church building). If wine is served on the Upper Patio, it shall be confined to the Upper Patio and not taken to parking areas or public sidewalk. If only the Upper Patio is used, these beverages shall not be taken into any building. For Church meals, wine may also be served in Anderson Lounge.
- 5. Alcoholic beverages shall not be sold on church property.
- 6. Responsible party shall monitor amount of wine served and compliance with applicable laws regarding consumption, particularly pertaining to minors. Responsible party is to ensure immediate removal from church grounds any guest deemed to be intoxicated.
- 7. Proof of liability insurance, with a minimum of \$1,000,000.00 liability coverage, and the church being shown as a "named insured", shall be given to the church Facilities Coordinator before the event. In order to be able to serve alcohol, it must state that it includes "host liquor liability".
